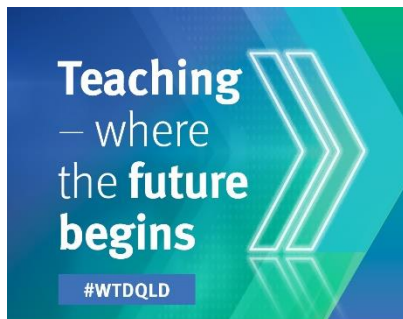
Jondaryan Cricket Carnival

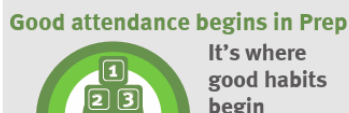

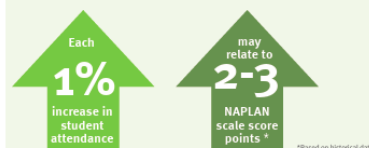
